ARTICLE 3 - FIVE-DAY WORK WEEK

Section 1. (a) Beginning on the date this Agreement becomes effective on any carrier, such carrier will establish, for all classes and crafts of yard service employees covered by this Article 3, subject to the exceptions contained therein, a workweek of 40 hours, **consisting of five consecutive days of eight hours each, with two days off in each seven**, except as hereinafter provided. The foregoing workweek rule is subject to all other provisions of this Article 3.
